2nd Half Tax Collections Due Dates Extended

Recent legislation, including **Ohio House Bill 186**, created an **Inflation Cap Credit** for certain property owners that may reduce tax obligations in second-half 2025 real estate tax bills. The law became effective in March 2026 and applies beginning with tax year 2025. These adjustments could not be included on first-half tax bills as the first half tax bills were due prior to the effective date of these pieces of legislation. As a result, eligible parcel(s) may receive a credit on their second-half tax bill. Please note that not all parcel(s) will qualify.

Our office is working closely with our software vendor to implement the changes required under H.B. 186 to accurately calculate any applicable credits. As additional software programming and testing are still underway, the due date for second-half 2025 real estate taxes has been extended to **July 31, 2026**. The due date for second-half 2026 mobile home taxes has also been extended to **August 14, 2026**.

Our office will continue to provide as much notice as possible, so taxpayers have time to prepare. Taxpayers who have already paid the full tax year and later receive an eligible credit will have that amount applied as a surplus to next year's tax bill.

If you prefer to pay your taxes in smaller installments, you may make weekly, biweekly, or monthly payments toward your parcel(s). Many taxpayers take advantage of these payment options, and those payments are posted to the appropriate parcel(s).
