2026 Second Half Real Estate Tax Collection in Huron County

- **Second half property taxes are due by 4:30 p.m. on July 31st, 2026.**
- Off-site tax collection locations are available. The schedule for the off-site tax collection for Huron County residents is as follows:
 - **Monday, July 13th, 2026, Wakeman Village Offices 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.**
 - **Wednesday, July 15th, 2026, New London Village Offices 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.**
 - **Thursday, July 16th, 2026, Willard Senior Enrichment Center 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.**
- Acceptable payments methods will be cash, check, money order, debit or credit card. A convenience fee will be applied to all transactions paid with a credit or debit card.
- New website is available to make payments and view tax bills and tax information. Please visit www.huroncountytreasurer.org.
- Tax bill payments can be dropped off 24/7 in the secure night drop, located inside the front door of the Treasurer's Office.
- The Treasurer's Office has received a permit from the City of Norwalk to reserve four parking spaces in front of the office at 16 East Main St. to help assist with access to persons paying taxes.
 - **The parking spaces will be available July 27th – July 31st, from 8 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.**
- **Manufactured home residents have a deadline of August 14th, 2026, to pay their second half taxes.**
- The Treasurer's Office is open from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.
- The Office will be closed for the following holiday, July 3rd, 2026, in observance of Independence Day.
